

- Move from site focus to enterprise integration – inter-relationships
- Employ and exploit emergency management lessons learned from defense sites and non-defense sites




Objectives

- Establish emergency management deficiency reporting across the DOE Emergency Management Enterprise.
- Enhance senior level management awareness of the existing deficiencies in the emergency management programs.



Current Actions

- Deputy Secretary letter to PSOs instructing defense nuclear facilities to report deficiencies and findings by September 1, 2015
- Submit emergency management deficiencies and findings electronically to SharePoint site
- NA-40 to compile report on emergency management deficiencies and findings to the Deputy Secretary by December 1, 2015
- Periodic reporting will be continue
- Reporting will be expanded to include non-defense facilities

Establish a Working Group


