

Example: DOE Requirements

DOE Order 151.1C, Chapter III Operational Emergency Base Program, Paragraph 3d(3)(b) states, “An event must be categorized as an Operational Emergency as promptly as possible, but no later than 15 minutes after event recognition/identification/discovery.”

Additionally, DOE Order 151.1C, Chapter VIII Communications Requirements, Paragraph 4a(1)(a) states in part “. . . of each DOE-/NNSA- or contractor-operated site/facility must—notify State and Local officials and the Cognizant Field Element Emergency Operation Center and Headquarters Operations Center within 15 minutes and all other organizations within 30 minutes of the declaration of an Alert, Site Area Emergency, or General Emergency. . .”
