

NNX Trusted Agent Agreement

Definition: A Trusted Agent is defined as a person with systems, technical, managerial or other associated skill assigned to the development, review, and/or approval of drill or exercise scenario materials.

Responsibility: The Trusted Agents are responsible for maintaining scenario security. **No scenario materials including general description, events or activities, technical or medical data and other types of scenario information will be released to persons participating in the drill or exercise.**

Roles or tasks: The following roles may be assigned to Trusted Agents:

1. Represent your organization in the development of scenario materials to provide the opportunity for the Participants to meet their drill or exercise objectives.
2. Development of technical data related to the scenario.
3. Independent review of scenario materials to ensure they are compliant with organization plans and procedures or best practices.
4. Review and approve the scenario for your organization.
5. If the Trusted Agent is also tasked to participate in the drill or exercise, the Trusted Agent will respond in accordance with the information provided in the drill or exercise and not from advance knowledge of the scenario.

I understand the responsibilities of being tasked as a drill or exercise Trusted Agent and agree to abide by the conditions established above.
