Use of Exercise Builder has been prepared by the Emergency Management Laboratory at the Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education under contract DE-AC05-06OR23100 to the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Emergency Management (NA-41).

This tool is not intended to establish policy or regulation. The objectives and evaluation criteria presented here are not to serve as:

- A stand-alone decision making tool for determining the adequacy of an emergency management program;
- A stand-alone substitute for guidance for the development of a drill/exercise program;
- A rule to determine if response elements are in compliance with local, state or federal regulations;
- A rule to determine whether a hazardous materials release must be reported to the overseeing regulatory agency;
- A set of final cleanup or action levels to be applied at contaminated sites;
- A guarantee that a real response was adequately executed; or
- Confirmation that any regulatory agency will agree with the conclusions of the drill and/or exercise assessment report produced as a result of use of this tool.

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**The objectives and criteria should NOT be used to determine when impacts at a site should be reported to a regulatory agency.** All releases of hazardous substances to the environment should be reported to the appropriate regulatory agency in accordance with governing regulations. Staff overseeing work at a specific site should be contacted prior to use of the information in this document to ensure that the document is applicable to the site and that the user has the most up-to-date version available.
